English

In English, we are starting the half term looking at the story *How Coyote Bought Fire to the Earth* and we will be focusing on descriptions and the use of adverbs and adjectives. We will then be looking at diary writing using the text *Man on the Moon* by Simon Bartram.

Maths

In Maths, we are looking at money, including recapping the previous work on addition and subtraction then moving on to looking at multiplication and division.

It is really important that the children continue to develop their quick recall of key addition and subtraction facts using 1 digit numbers - regular practice of Numbots will support this.

Science

In science this half term we will be answering the question 'What is the animal kingdom?' We will be finding out about the human body, living things and habitats.

History

We will be doing some history work looking at how life has change in living memory which will involve looking at how toys, technology and transport has changed over recent years.

PSHE

This term in PSHE we will be continuing to look at our zones of regulation for how we deal with our emotions and feelings.
