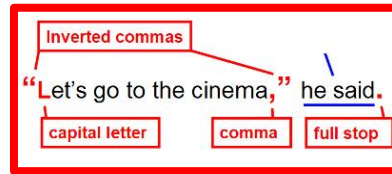


M1) To use capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks, question marks and commas correctly.

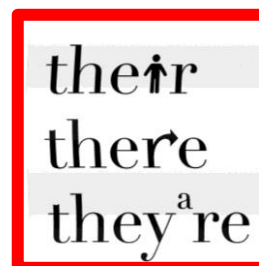
